Naval Science

Monday: LSD: An LSD, or Dock Landing Ship, is a warship that supports amphibious operations by transporting and launching vehicles, craft, and personnel onto hostile shores

Tuesday: A frigate is a type of warship. In different eras, the roles and capabilities of ships classified as frigates have varied. The name frigate in the 17th to early 18th

centuries was given to any full-rigged ship built for speed and maneuverability, intended to be used in scouting, escort and patrol roles.

Wednesday: A destroyer is a fast, maneuverable, long-endurance warship intended to escort larger vessels in a fleet, convoy, or carrier battle group and defend them.

Thursday: A ballistic missile submarine is a submarine capable of deploying submarine-launched ballistic missiles with nuclear warheads. These submarines became a major weapon system in the Cold War because of their nuclear deterrence capability.

Friday: An aircraft carrier is a warship that serves as a seagoing airbase, equipped with a full-length flight deck and facilities for carrying, arming, deploying, and recovering aircraft. Typically, it is the capital ship of a fleet, as it allows a naval force to project air power worldwide without depending on local bases for staging aircraft operations.
